Oral presentation, abstract, listener.

*To participate in the conference by **March 15, 2025** (this day inclusive) it is necessary to send an application for participation and the abstract of the report (no more than 2 pages, requirements and a sample of the design are attached in the appendix) to the e-mail address of the responsible secretary of the conference (nephrology.uzbekistan@gmail.com).*

The name of the files containing the abstract of the report and the application must match the last name of the first author.

For those wishing to participate **competition of young scientists** The report must be submitted no later than April 1, 2025.

Works submitted for participation in the conference must not have been previously published. The editorial board reserves the right to decide whether to publish works in the collection.

WORKS SUBMITTED TO THE ORGANIZING COMMITTEE LATER THAN THE STATED DEADLINE AND NOT FORMATED IN ACCORDANCE WITH REQUIREMENTS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED!

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS FOR THE DESIGN OF THE THESIS

Abstracts can be submitted in Uzbek, Russian and English.

Word format, Times New Roman 12 font; 1.0 spacing, volume up to 2 A4 pages, margins: top and bottom - 2 cm, right - 1.5 cm, left - 2.5 cm. Abstracts without the requirements will not be accepted for publication. No more than 3 works will be accepted from one author. The number of authors in the abstracts should be not more than 3.

THESIS STRUCTURE

1. Title of the work in CAPITAL bold letters;

2. Full names of authors

3. Place of work (full official name of the institution sending the publication), city and country

4. Next, after one line, the text of the thesis should contain:

The relevance of the problem

Target

Material and methods

Results

Conclusions

5. The abstract should not contain figures, graphs, diagrams or other illustrations. Footnotes to cited works should not be made. The abstract should reflect the results of previously unpublished original scientific research.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ORAL PRESENTATION

1. The presentation must be accompanied by a presentation (PowerPoint 2003-2007).

2. The duration of an oral presentation (report) should not exceed 7-10 minutes.

3. You will be provided with a multimedia projector and a laptop as technical equipment. Due to the different software on the laptops, please save your presentations in two extensions (.ppt and .pptx)

4. If you need assistance from the Organizing Committee in demonstrating your presentation, please prepare a separate copy of your report indicating the exact scenario.

5. The presentation should have a classic structure: a title slide indicating the name of the university, the name of the department, the title of the work, the full name of the speaker, the full name of the scientific supervisor (position, academic degree, academic rank), city and year. Numbering of all slides; then a section on the relevance of the work, materials and methods, the results obtained, findings, conclusion.

The organizing committee reserves the right to reject materials that do not correspond to the purpose of the conference. The authors of the abstracts are personally responsible for the content and literacy of the materials provided.
